## summary



*This booklet contains advices how to behave in the PLA Beskydy.*

*The Protected Landscape Area (PLA) Beskydy was established in 1973. With its area of 1 200 square kilometres the PLA Beskydy is the largest protected landscape area in the Czech Republic and is the only one where lynxes, wolves and bears live. There are also rests of original old forests, meadows and pastures with orchids and junipers and old wooden houses.*

*The protection of nature and landscape in the PLA Beskydy should be in the public interest of its residents as well as its visitors.*

*The rarest localities in the PLA Beskydy are protected as National Nature Reserves (with the strictest protection), Nature Reserves and Nature Monuments. There are fifty of these specially protected areas all together.*

*Protected areas are marked by table with state emblem.*

*The PLA Beskydy is special in terms of the original old forests, the rare Carpathian animals and plants, and the multifarious meadows and pastures.*

*It's important to keep this land by considerate management. It's forbidden to pollute the environment with wastes. Everybody, who wants to build a house in the PLA Beskydy, has to have a permit from the Administration of the PLA Beskydy.*

*Rangers and the Czech Environmental Inspectorate reduce or suspend harmful activities, breaching of valid legislation and rules.*
